COOKIES AND SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES

We at Brite AB, registration no. 559116-1632, ("Brite", "we", "us") use cookies and similar technologies (collectively referred to as "cookies") in our payment client in connection with your use of Brite's payment services.

We use cookies to automate the completion of your personal information in our client, which are needed to initiate a transaction and to facilitate payment flows. This allows you to save certain personal information, namely your customer-ID with Brite.

We use cookies to collect the above information from Brite's servers when you use Brite's services from the same device. We then complete your personal information into forms when you use Brite's service again. We save a token that gives us access to your account information for 90 days. Below, we explain in more detail how we use cookies and the choices you can make about our cookies. At the end of this notice, there is a complete list of all cookies used on our client.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A cookie is a small text file containing information that is stored on your computer, mobile, tablet or other technical device when you visit a website or use a mobile application. Some cookies are necessary for a website or an application to work effectively, while others are used to improve your experience or to get an overview of your activity.

Cookies are stored on your device for different duration of time, depending on the function and purpose of the specific cookie. A cookie that is only used for the proper functioning of a website is deleted after your visit (session cookie), while those used to recognise you and remember your preferences for your next visit will be stored on your device for a longer period of time (persistent cookie).

Furthermore, a cookie may be placed by us, as the first party, or by another actor, a third party, on our behalf (third-party cookie). However, it is always us who control which cookies are used on our client.

WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES DOES BRITE USE?

We use functional cookies to provide you with the most personalized user experience possible. The technical storage of these functional cookies is necessary for the provision of the services requested by you. If these cookies are disabled, the functionality of Brite's services will be limited.

CONSENT MANAGEMENT

When you use Brite's client for a deposit, you are automatically giving your consent to the

use of cookies in order to be remembered and receive a faster payment flow on your next payment. You can remove stored cookies by clearing your browser history or decline cookies being stored (in your browser settings).
